

ATU Library How To: Find articles on the Library's Databases

There are millions of articles available on the library's databases. The easiest way to find these articles is to use the 'Search + Find' feature on the library's homepage. (The library also has separate subscriptions to a number of ejournals not available through the databases.)

Part 1: Carrying out a search and limiting the results to articles only

1. Type your topic into the search box and press the blue 'Search' button. In the example below I am looking for articles on research methods.


3. Advanced Search gives you more fields to fill in so you can refine your topic. You can add in more blank fields using the + button



- By selecting 'Full Text Online' your results will contain the full text of articles, as opposed to abstracts (summaries) of articles.
- Any article published in a 'peer-reviewed' journal was closely examined by a panel of reviewers, who are experts on the article's topic. Peer reviewed articles are the most authoritative sources of information for college-level research papers.

Then press the 'Search' button in the bottom right-hand corner.


6. By using the Advanced Search option, and selecting 'Full Text' and 'Peer Reviewed' the number of results has reduced to under 42, 000



The results still include, articles, conference materials, reviews, trade publications etc. There are a number of different filters on the left-hand side of the screen, to refine your results further

7. To limit it to just journal articles: select 'Academic Journals' underneath 'Source Types'




