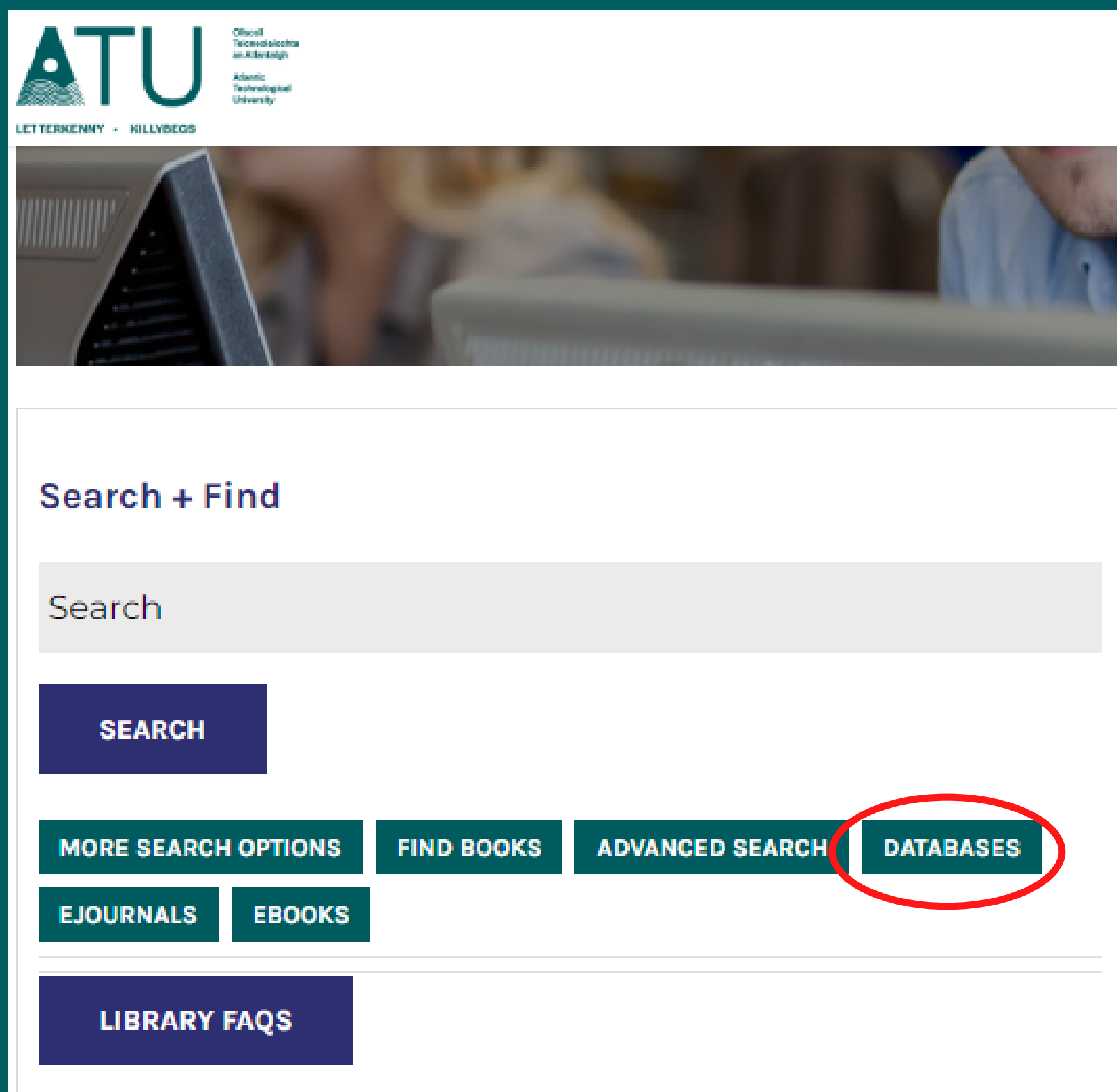


ATU Library How To: Search Newspapers online

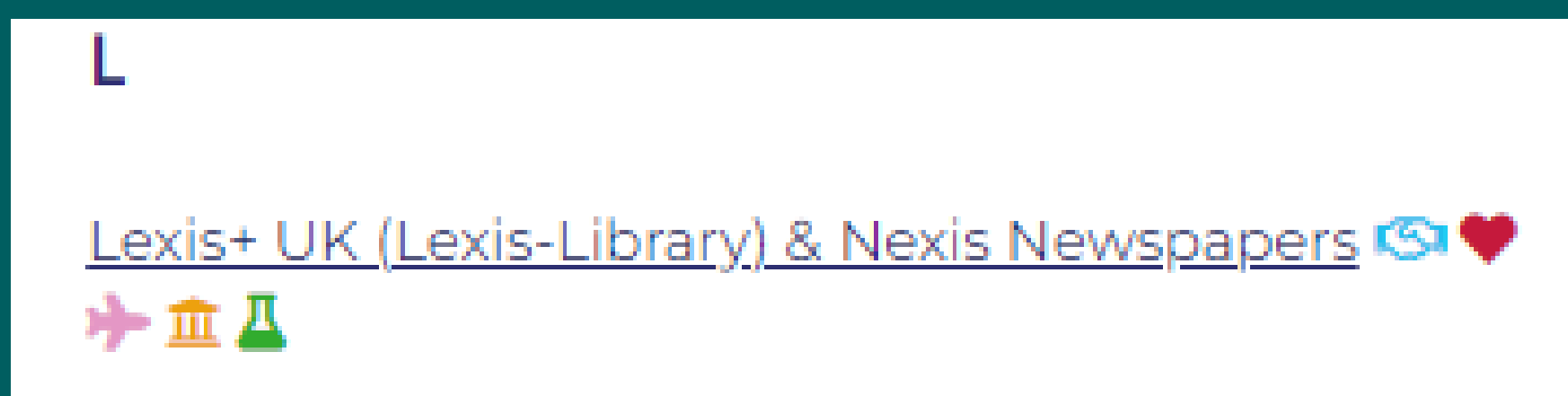
The library subscribes to a large number of major world newspapers, national and regional newspapers, newsletters, blogs, newswires and press releases. The service is called 'Nexis' and is hosted on the database Lexis+ UK.

These resources are not searchable through the Search + Find tool, so you need to go into the Lexis+ UK database directly.

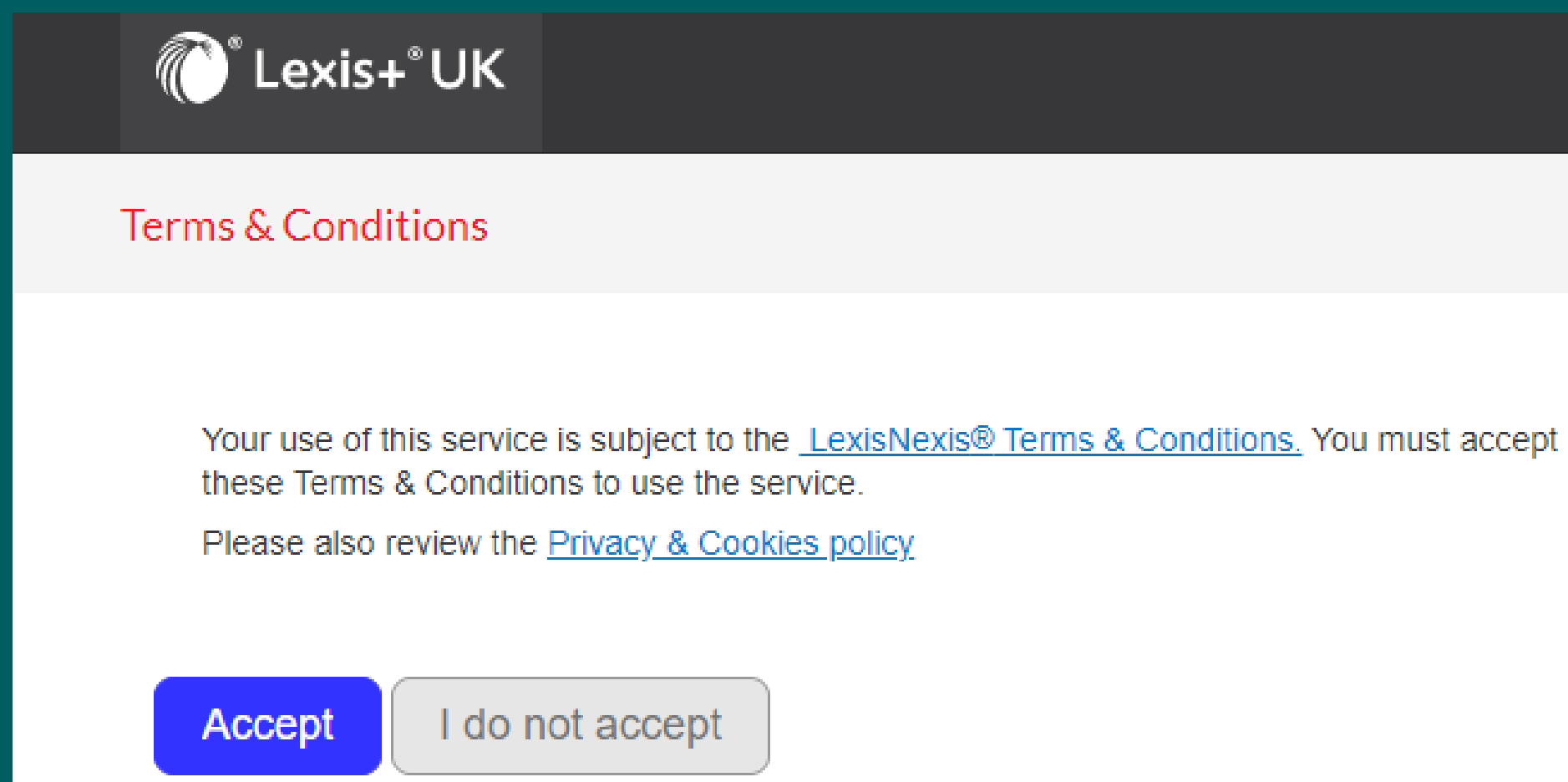
1. On the Library homepage, click on the 'Databases' button



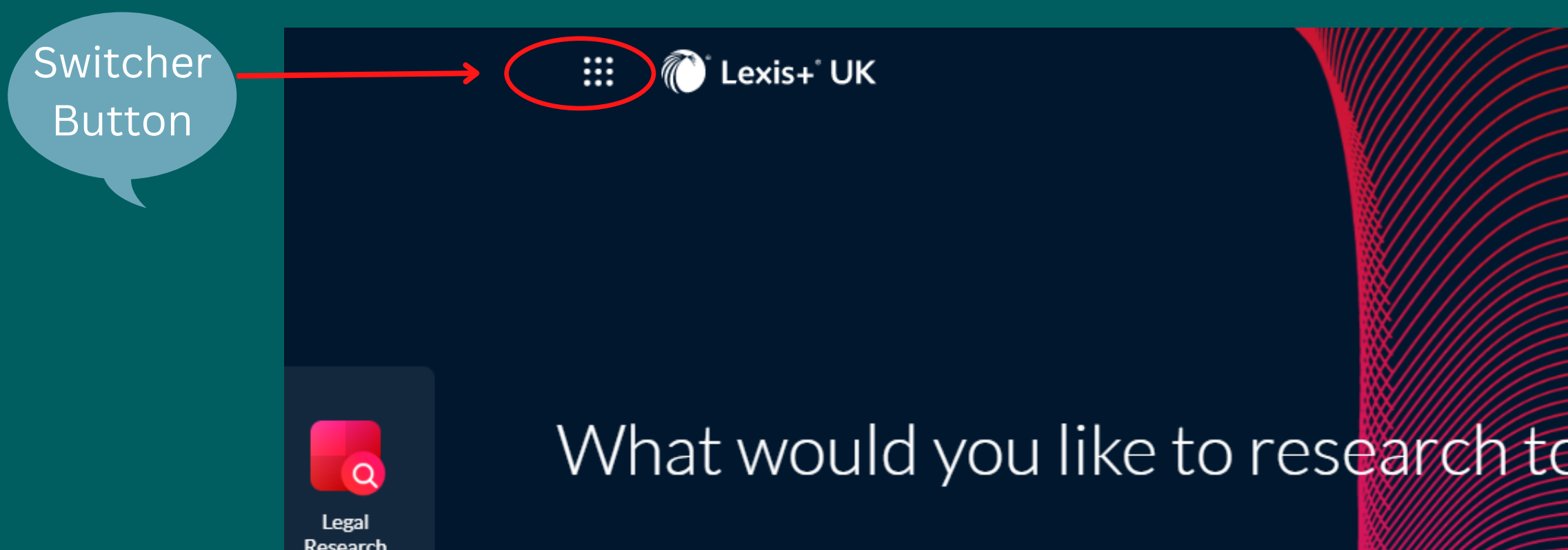
2. Scroll down to the databases listed under 'L'- Lexis+ UK



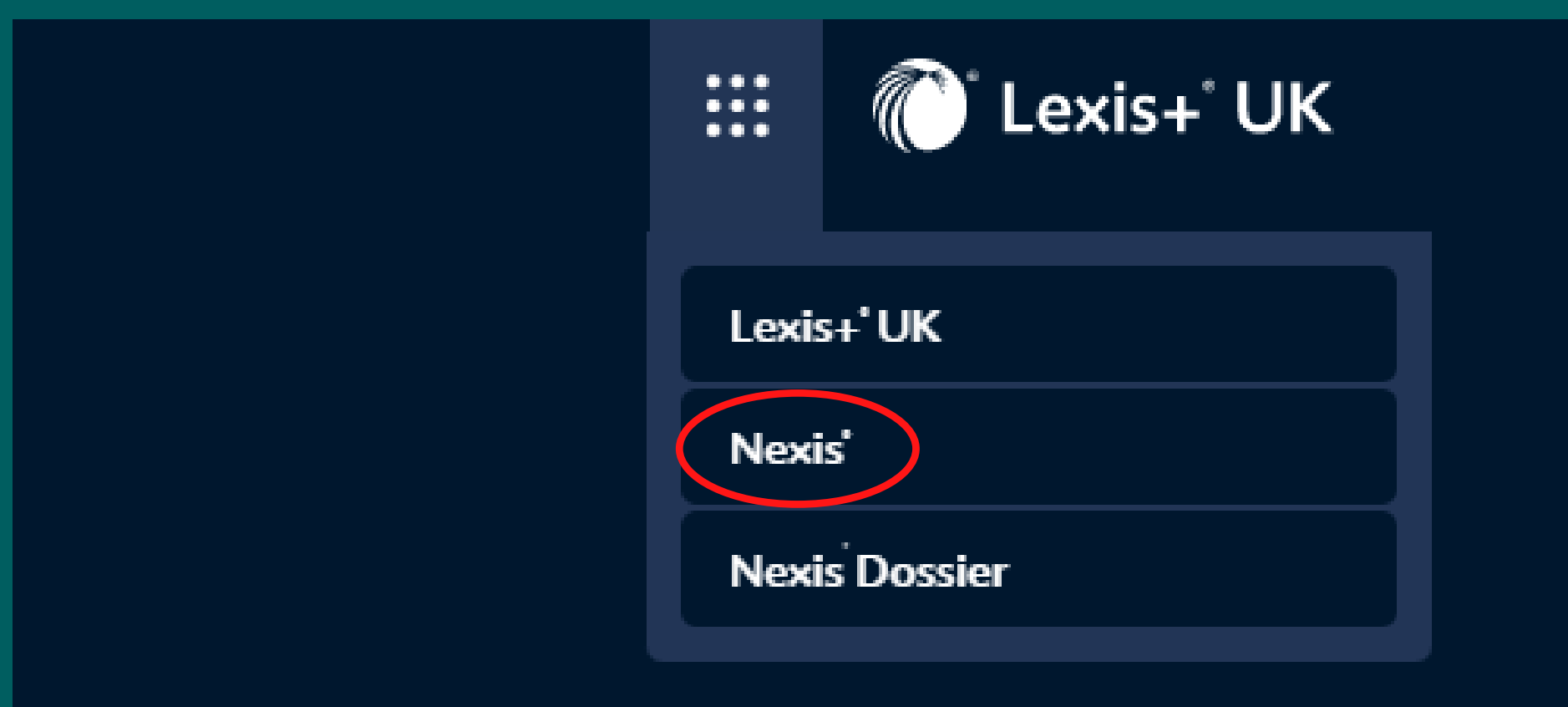
3. It will ask you to accept the terms and conditions



4. You will be taken to the homepage of Lexis+ UK. Click on the small set of 9 squares in the top left-hand corner – this is called the switcher button (to switch to another product)



5. Click on the word 'Nexis' to access the database hosting the newspapers



6. This takes you to the 'Nexis' database. Click on 'News' in the top toolbar for the newspapers.



Two useful ways to search the contents of Nexis News are:

1. Searching across all the News resources at the same time
2. Searching Newspapers from a specific country

1. Searching across all the News resources at the same time

You can search across all the different resources in one go, using the search field on the Nexis homepage.

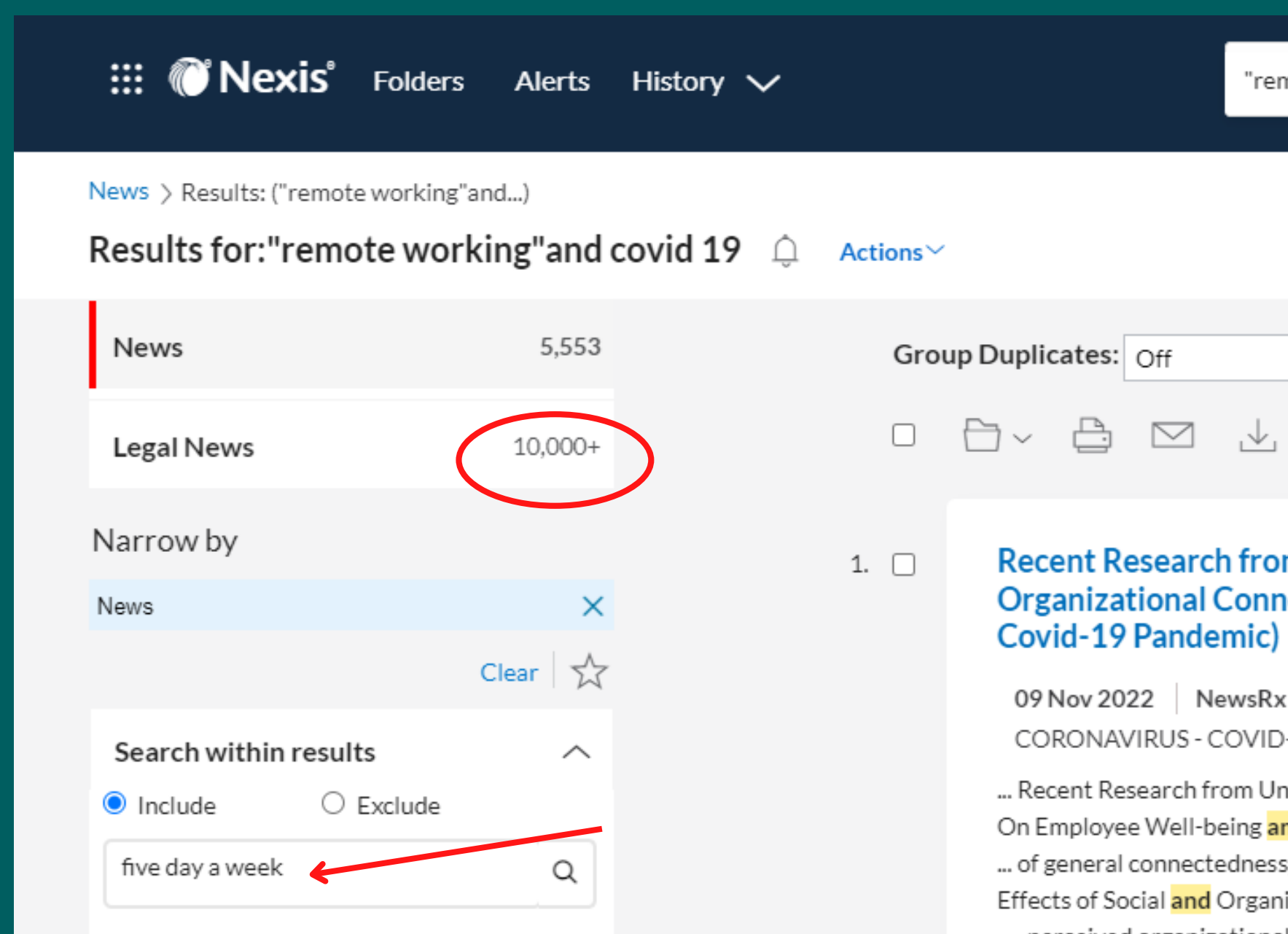
Type your search terms into the search bar and press the blue search button



This search has resulted in over 10,000 articles.

Refining your results

(A) You can add further search terms, or exclude search terms, using the 'Search Within Results' field



(B) You can refine by year(s), language, country, industry, geography etc. using the drop-down options on the menu bar on the left-hand side of the results page.

Once you open a drop-down menu heading, click on what you want to refine your results by e.g., subject or industry. Click on 'More', if available, to see all the options for refining under that heading.

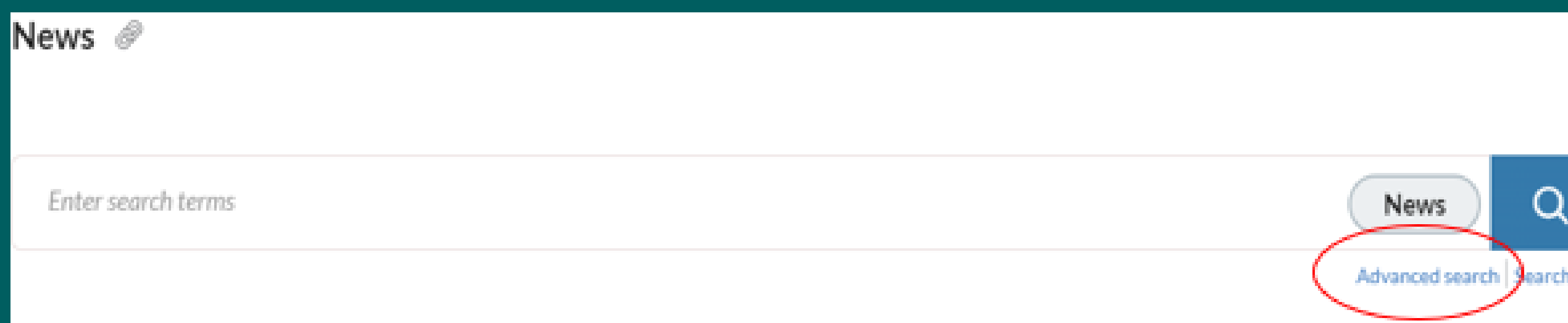

Advanced Searching

Another tool for searching is the 'Advanced Search', which provides specific fields to fill in to refine your search.

On the Nexis news homepage click on Advanced search, below the Simple search field



The 'connectors' box on the right-hand side of the page provides help with using Boolean operators to help refine your search.

When you add words and phrases into the search fields, Press the 'Add' button. If you don't do this, whatever you typed in the field will not be added to the search.

Use connectors

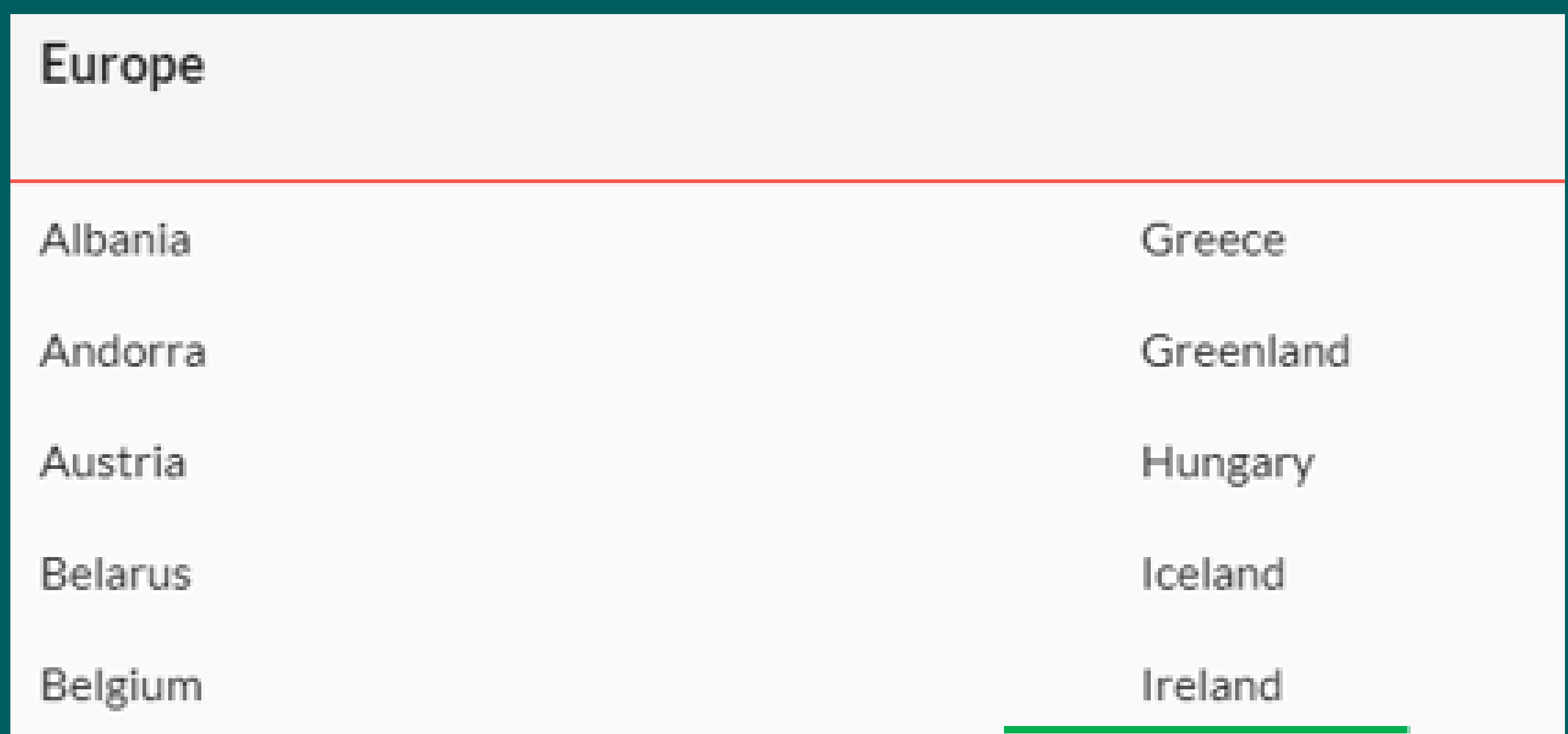
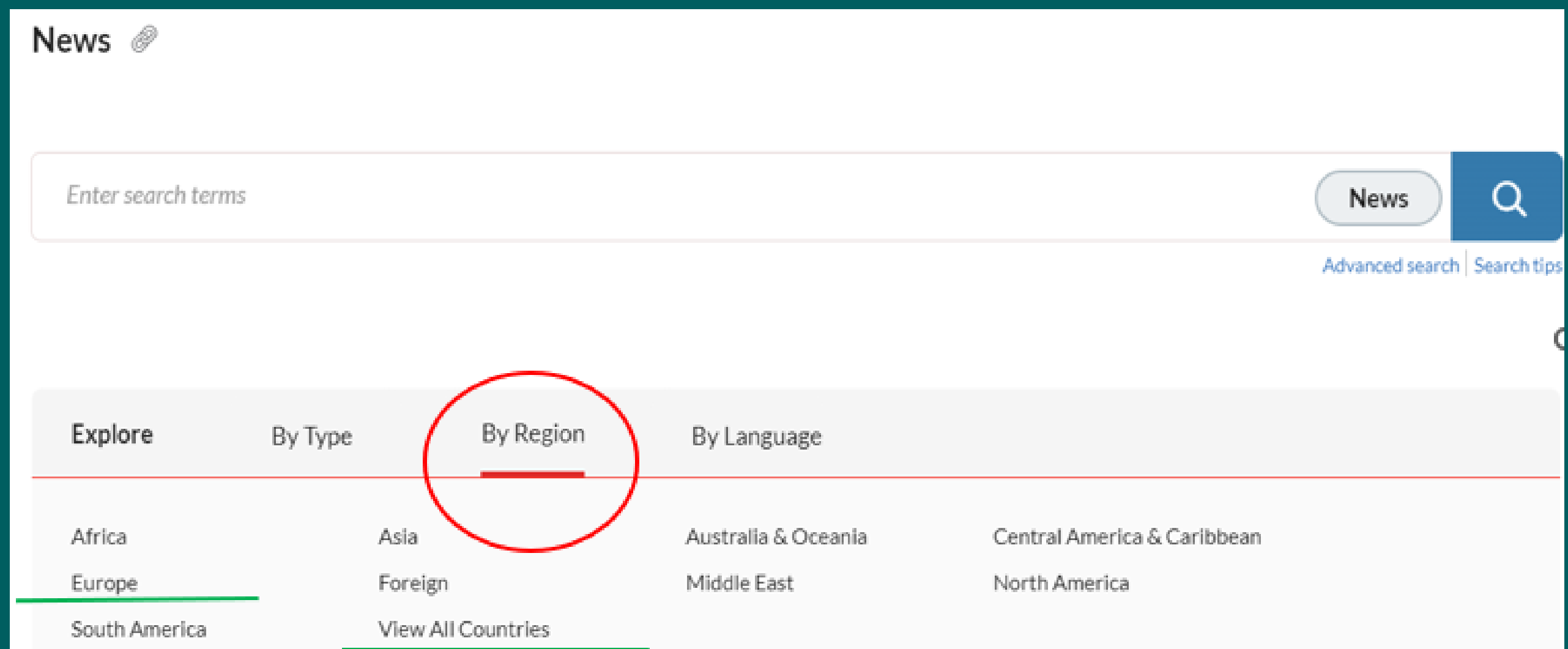

2. Searching Newspapers from a specific country e.g., Ireland

We are going to focus on news resources from Ireland. On the Nexis News homepage, select 'By Region'. Then select 'Europe' or you can select 'View All Countries'. Select 'Ireland'



When you select a country, it will show a list of all the local, regional, and national papers that are available to search. Clicking on the little 'i' beside each title will tell you the frequency, update schedule and a description of the newspaper.
