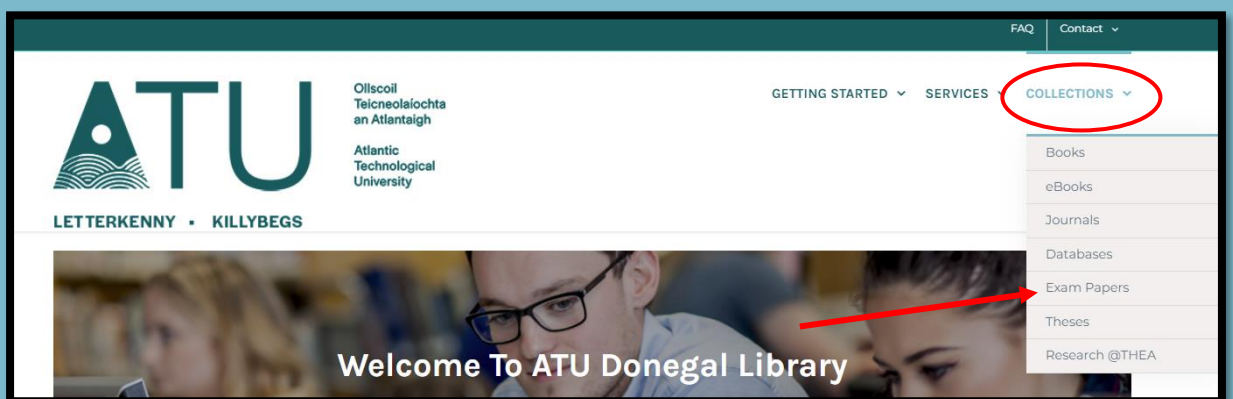


ATU Library How To: Find Past Exam papers

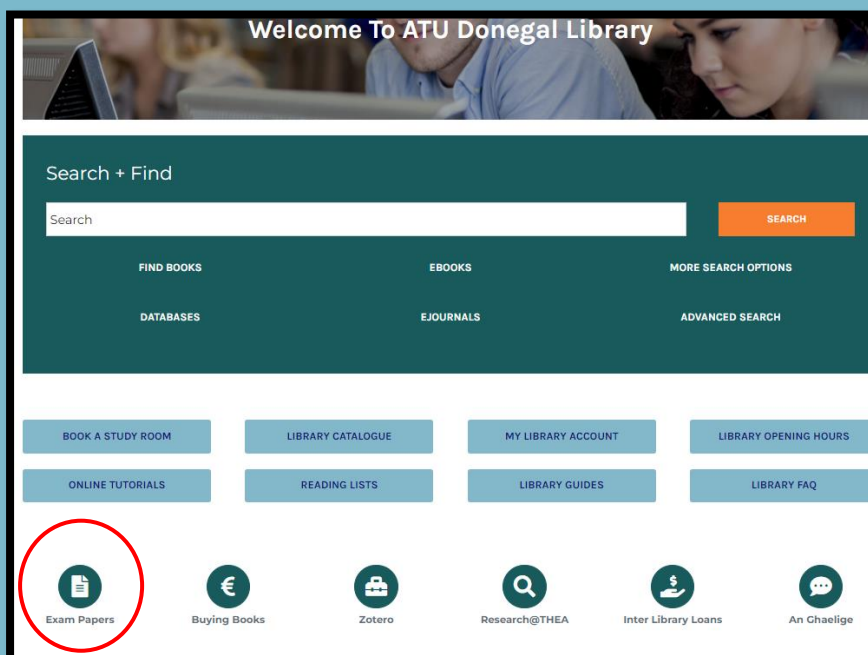
The library receives past exam papers from the various schools. They include papers from first, second, third, fourth and master's years. They are available in pdf format and are accessible on and off campus. Repositories of past papers are updated, on an on-going basis, and include papers from the previous five years.

1. There are two ways to access the past exam papers from the library homepage:

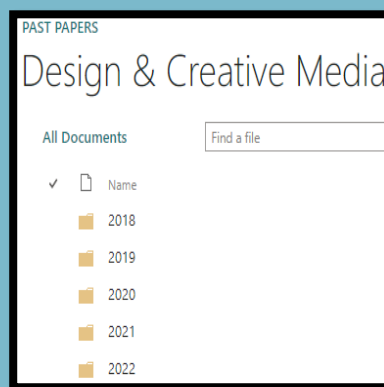
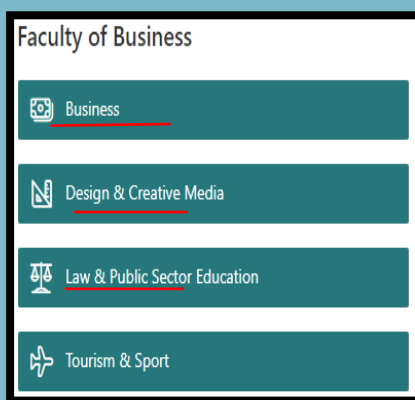
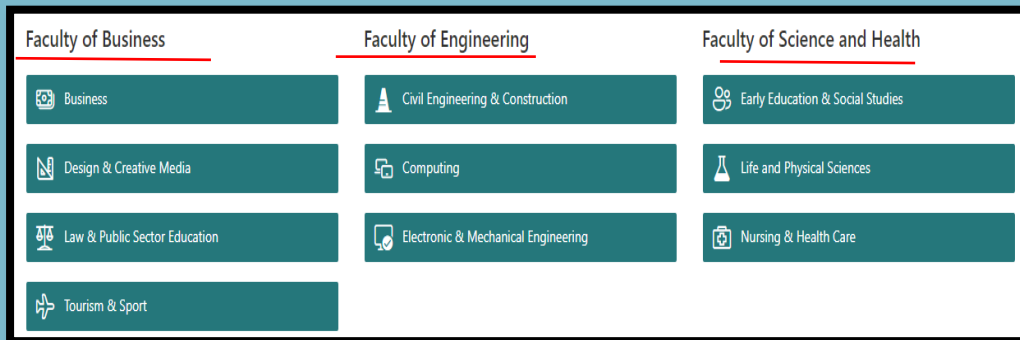
Click on the 'Collections' tab in the top right-hand corner of the library homepage and select 'exam papers' from the drop-down menu



Scroll down to the middle of the library homepage and you will see a picture of sheet of paper with 'Exam Papers' written underneath

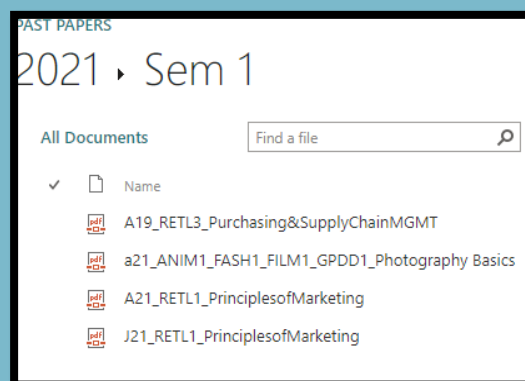
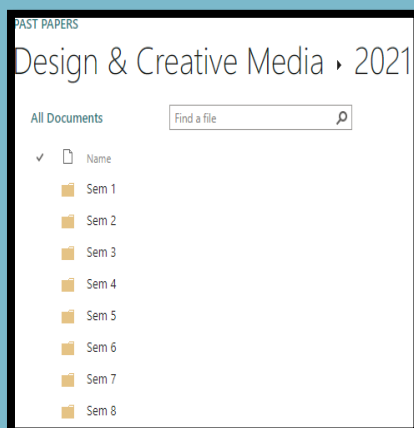


- The papers are organised by Faculty, then Year, then Semester, then course. Simply click into the paper you are looking for by moving through these categories.

Year

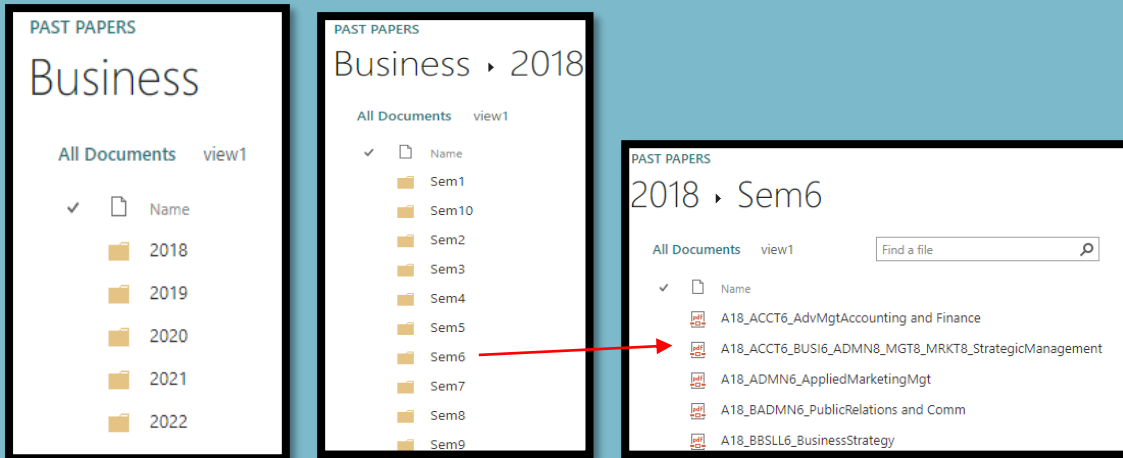


Semester
